INSTRUCTIONS

. Cut 2 inch lengths off each end of your popsicle stick. 2. Take a chunk of clay and shape it in a quarter size mound, as shown. 3. Stick your two flat stick ends into the bottom of your clay mound. 4. Place your fork down into the top of the clay mound. 5.
